

Need gutter cleaning?



Not sure if you need gutter cleaning?

Gutters protect against water damage to your home.

Gutters only work properly when they are free from leaves and debris.

What are the main signs to look for that indicate your gutters require cleaning?

Gutter Maintenance Signs

Water is overflowing.

Water spilling over the sides means the gutter is blocked at some point, and the water can no longer flow freely down the drainpipe into the drains below. This is a sure-fire sign of when to clean gutters.

The gutter has a sag.

If you notice a slight sag or bend in your gutter, it could be due to the weight of potential debris lying inside or even a build of water, weighing the area down at a certain point.

Debris can be surprisingly heavy, so it is important to remove it before it causes further damage.

Stains are beginning to appear.

Standing water in your gutters will soon become dirty and stagnant if it has nowhere to go, causing staining issues.

Animals and insects are present.

Debris and decomposing leaves are ideal nesting grounds for mice, birds, and insects.

Plants/weeds are growing.

If you see weeds sprouting from above, it is certainly time to clean your gutters.

You have not cleaned your gutters in a while.

We recommend gutter cleaning at least twice a year, ideally in late spring and then again in Autumn.

If you have not cleaned your gutters out in a while, consider doing a visual inspection to check your gutters. Walking around your home during the next

heavy rain, look for water spilling over the top of gutters and checking to see that water is flowing at the end of each downspout.
